We have strengthened our good cooperation with the international partners and implemented for us few very important educational capacity grants: (a) The final event of 200,000 USD ALCOA Foundation grant - the Global Engineer International Forum - took place in Denver, USA on 17th March 2016; (b) Six EWB member associations implemented within the Tetra Tech's 50th Anniversary Global Clean Water Fund, the 50,000 USD grant program that supported selected projects providing clean water for communities in need; (c) Arconic Foundation announced provision of a 130,000 USD grant to EWB-I that will facilitate the development of innovative educational practices around the world.
