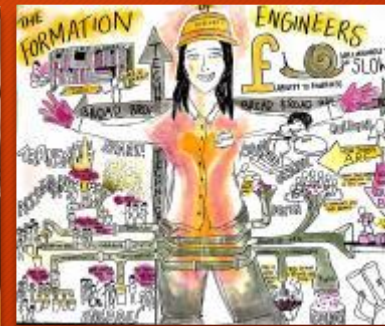
Increase collaboration
